An estimated 40 million people are enslaved in our world today.

Women, men, and children are forced to do things they don't want to do, under the threat of violence, in industries such as:



commercial
sex trade

service



factories +
construction



restaurants

But we believe human trafficking is a symptom of a deeper problem.

The real problem is that relationships, communities, and systems are broken. In order to end slavery, we need to start by rebuilding community.

Basing our action on discipleship, community, and the character of Jesus, we seek to address the root causes of exploitation: poverty, racism, gender inequality, abuse, and more. We partner with all

sectors of society—from academia and law to faith and social services—to form a holistic approach.

But our community-focused, Jesus-centered approach is about more than seeking justice for the oppressed.

It's about pursuing shalom.

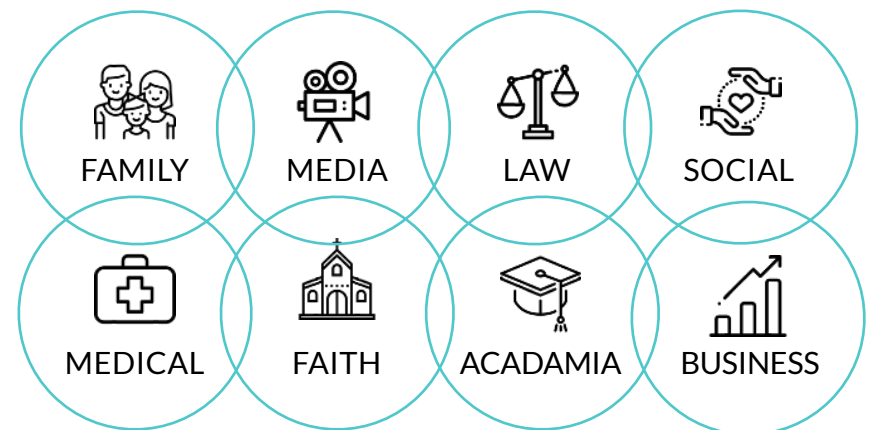


ABOUT US

Our vision is to see the vulnerable protected, captives set free, and the oppressed experiencing hope and healing as neighborhoods are transformed.

Our mission is to mobilize faith communities, financial partners, and all segments of society towards ending human trafficking and creating new futures through community-based action.

We are comprised of 40+ teams in our international impact network that are intolerant of exploitation and equipped to address the root causes of slavery in their neighborhoods. With your support, teams like the ones listed below can strengthen their capacity to holistically engage in strategic ways to influence all sectors of society.



Extending Mercy at the Margins

Meet a few of our teams doing this **transformational work**:
By mobilizing their local community, teams serve those who are marginalized, and most at risk of trafficking. They extend unconditional care, counseling services, training sessions, hygiene packets, emotional support, and more to reduce human trafficking vulnerabilities in the communities they call home.

Flint, MI Street Outreach

Through street outreach, the team in Michigan provides women involved in prostitution with physical and emotional needs such as hygiene packets, unconditional support, and care.



Canfield, OH Strip Club Ministry

An estimated 84% of women in prostitution are under third-party control, pimped,* or trafficked.* The team in Ohio works alongside local partners to minister and mentor women in strip clubs to prevent human trafficking and create new futures.

Hungary Prison Ministry

Our national leader supports the poor, elderly, unemployed, and at-risk people with life skill development and psychological counseling. She also seeks to mobilize churches, train and support youth, equip service providers, and unite the abolitionist movement in Hungary.



Taiwan Caring for Immigrants

Members from several local churches form this team, mobilizing their community to reach the most underserved groups in their area and address the links between slavery and vulnerabilities such as poverty.

Child and youth Protection

Meet a few of our teams doing this **vital work**:

Our teams across the globe bring hope and healing to children that are vulnerable to being trafficked through awareness, prevention, and intervention methods. They educate, advocate, support, and mentor children to increase their resiliency to human trafficking.

Seattle, WA Fostering Hope

Fostering Hope provides tangible avenues of hope for youth as they exit foster homes through support and encouragement, while also offering support and resources to families and social workers.



McPherson, KS Backpacks for Kids

Children, taken from their home due to child protection concerns, are offered a sense of comfort and dignity as the team in Kansas partners with the local Police Departments to provide them with backpacks in times of elevated stress.



Colombia Support & Mentorship

Vulnerable children and families are supported and mentored in Colombia through an after-school program by increasing resiliency to human trafficking through education-focused support programs and workshops.

Hungry State Homes for Children

Our team in Hungary supports at-risk children through weekly English lessons, Bible studies, mentoring, and games. They work to establish a safe place for youth to find belonging rather than on the streets or in a gang.



Kenya Young Adult Mentorship

Our team in Kenya works to disciple young female leaders by mentoring them to become role models and sources of support to other young women.

Education, Awareness, and Training

Meet a few of our teams doing this **high-priority work**: Through community-based action, teams create locally-informed awareness campaigns and equip societal influencers with the tools and resources they need to educate others. Through dedicated training, equipping, educating, and advocating, communities come together to reduce the vulnerabilities of human trafficking.

Decatur, IL Online Safety

Our team in Decatur, Illinois educates and trains children, parents, and school officials on social media and online safety.



Kenya Support & Training

In Kenya, Thrive is a place where young women are being trained to help shift harmful value systems that perpetuate injustices. They strive to build a resilient community with zero tolerance for gender-based violence, and human trafficking.



India Educate & Equip

Leaders in India raise critical awareness regarding human trafficking, equip caregivers and churches to protect their children against child exploitation, and navigate avenues of resource access.



Philippines Training Pastors

Leaders in India raise critical awareness regarding human trafficking, equip caregivers and churches to protect their children against child exploitation, and navigate avenues of resource access.



Freedom Forum & Community Conversations

SFM hosts events like Freedom Forum and Community Conversations to educate communities about trafficking issues in their neighborhoods and build partnerships.

Protect at least 100,000 youth

Influence more than 1 million people towards freedom

Help bring hope and healing to more than 30,000 survivors

Fully fund more than 50 independent freedom initiatives around the globe.

Have half of our budget revenue generated by locally managed businesses.

Four tax-wise, year-end giving strategies that benefit both you and anti-trafficking efforts:

Gift of Appreciated Assets - Giving from appreciated, non-cash assets such as securities or real estate provide you with a "double deduction." The combined savings are greater than a cash gift and will not affect your cash flow.

Donor-Advised Fund - This is an excellent tool if you want a year-end tax deduction but need more time to make a decision on gift designations.

Charitable Life Income Plan - This plan allows you to make a charitable gift now and receive lifetime annuity payments.

Qualified Charitable Distribution - If you are over 70 years and own an IRA, a direct gift is the most tax-efficient way to give, whether or not you itemize on your tax return. This is a great way to utilize Required Minimum Distributions.
